A Reading from the Gospel of Luke (Luke 1:35-38)

The angel Gabriel said to Mary, 'The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be holy; he will be called Son of God. And now, your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son, for nothing will be impossible with God.'

Then Mary said,

*'Here am I, the servant of the Lord;
let it be with me according to your word.'*

She arises and sets out, for she is certain that God's plan is the best plan for her life.

Pope Francis asks us: "What leads you to feel a need to get up and go?"


Chat in pairs: What good - or bad - things have you seen that make you want to make haste like Mary did, to share a message or make a change in the world?

*A Reading from the Gospel of Matthew
(Matthew 28:5-10)*

The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay. Then go quickly and tell his disciples: 'He has risen from the dead and is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him.' Now I have told you."

So the women hurried away from the tomb, afraid yet filled with joy, and ran to tell his disciples. Suddenly Jesus met them. "Greetings," he said. They came to him, clasped his feet and worshiped him. Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid. Go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee; there they will see me."

Mary's focus is always directed outwards. She is the woman of Easter... going forth from herself towards God and others...
